
(1) Dimension

- Chip size: 4mil x 8mil ($104 \pm 15\mu\text{m}$ x $204 \pm 15\mu\text{m}$)
- Thickness: 3.1mil ($80 \pm 10 \mu\text{m}$)
- Anode pad: $45 \pm 10 \mu\text{m}$ x $64 \pm 10 \mu\text{m}$
- Cathode pad: $45 \pm 10 \mu\text{m}$ x $64 \pm 10 \mu\text{m}$



Fig.1 – Relative luminous Intensity vs. Forward Current




Fig.2 – Forward Current vs. Forward Voltage




Fig.3 – Relative Intensity (@1mA) vs. Ambient Temperature




Fig.4 – Forward Voltage (@1mA) vs. Ambient Temperature




Fig.5 – Dominant Wavelength (@1mA) vs. Ambient Temperature




Fig.6 – Maximum Driving Forward DC Current vs. Ambient Temperature (De-rating based on T_j max. = 115°C)
